User-Agent: gptbot
Disallow: /
# Allow Google's AI systems to access all content
User-Agent: google-extended
Allow: /
# Block Meta's crawler
User-Agent: facebookexternalhit
Disallow: /
# Partially block Anthropic's ClaudeBot (deny training access)
User-Agent: claudebot
Disallow: /
# Allow Perplexity to index only specific resources
User-Agent: perplexitybot
Allow: /blog/
Disallow: /private/
# Global block as fallback for unknown bots
User-Agent: *
Disallow: /checkout/
Disallow: /campaigns/
```
